Duties:

- Monitor and prepare reports on developments in the fields of industrial technology, business, finance, and economic theory and stay current in connection with developments in the fields of industrial technology, business, finance, and economic theory.
- Prepare informed investment analysis by analyzing financial information including financial information related to M&A involved companies to produce forecasts of business, industry, and economic conditions for use in making investment decisions as well as financial information related to Special situations which looks at specific triggers for stock performance besides just the M&A potential, which include, spin-offs, post bankruptcies, divestitures and legal contracts;
- Evaluate and analyze the financial position of M&A involved companies, specifically the companies' balance sheets, filings and debt profiles in order to identify specific events in the relevant industry including liquidity crisis events such as breaches in debt covenants, failure to pay interest, and default on repayment of principal.
- Use research reports pertaining to specific companies to interpret data on price, future investment trends, economic influences, and other factors affecting M&A deals that are published by Mergermarket and its affiliate publications.
- Provide analysis of ongoing M&A situations utilizing knowledge of securities law, charts, graphs and computer spreadsheets.
- Generate ideas for product development for Mergermarket and its affiliate publications.
